Banquet Seating

Rectangular tables 8-10 square feet per person Round tables seating 6-10 people 10-15 square feet per person

Cocktail Parties and Receptions

All standing 6-10 square feet per person Some seated 8-15 square feet per person

Additional Allowance

Dance floor area 4-5 square feet per person

Beverage/bar area 100 square feet Buffet area (per 8' table) 100 square feet

Seating Capacity Per Table

24" - 44" round2-6 people6' x 24" banquet6-8 people8' x 24" banquet8-10 people60" round8-10 people72" Round10-12 people

Along with planning the number of guests, it is a good idea to figure in other activities, events, presentations and meals to get the best accurate seating schedule. Every event requires some planning and attention to the smaller details which means the difference between an ordinary event and one that people will remember forever.

When sizing your tent, always plan for the worst case weather scenario.
